Great Barton Parish council objects to DC/25/0039/OUT Land off The Park Great Barton for the following reasons: (unanimous decision)

This application is set within the Park Special Character Area of Great Barton and does not accord with Great Barton Neighbourhood Plan:

GB10 any development should be accompanied by a design statement that recognises the distinct built and natural characteristics of the area and building should be subservient to the woodland setting.

GB12 Great Barton Neighbourhood Plan - The addition of three new dwellings and sub division of the plot would erode the existing landscaped character of the site, and would be out of character and contrary to GB12.

DM24 (a) of WSC JDMPD - Development within the curtilage should respect the character, scale, and design of existing dwellings.

DM2 (d) not involve the loss of gardens and important open, green or landscaped areas which make a significant contribution to the character and appearance of the settlement.
