DC/25/1967/TPO - Barton House, The Park - TPO 370(1974) tree preservation order - one yew and one holm oak (marked T1 and T2 on plan and within A6 on order) overall crown reduction by four metres, one sycamore (marked T3 on plan and within A6 on order) overall crown reduction by three metres, one sycamore (marked T4 on plan and within A5 on order) fell, one sycamore (marked T5 on plan and within A5 on order) large lateral limb to be reduced by up to five metres overhanging neighbours property, one London plane (marked T6 on plan and within A6 on order) overall crown reduction by three metres, one sycamore (marked T7 on plan and within A6 on order) overall crown reduction by two metres.

**Cllrs reviewed the submitted Tree Location Plan. The meeting resolved that there are no objections, subject to agreement with West Suffolk Tree Officer, all in favour.**
