The Housing Needs Survey shows that the majority of residents have no housing requirements. However SEBC's Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment (SHLAA) has identified four additional sites that might be suitable for development. The landowners are keen for the development to take place and developers are already interested in the sites. If the NPWG do not identify any sites in the NP planning applications may still be submitted for sites and if SEBC has a housing shortage they may be keen for them to proceed.	
Those members attending the meeting felt there was a need to bring to residents attention that development may happen and it is better to influence it in the NP. It was proposed to hold a Drop-in on Saturday 21 April 2018, (subject to the availability of the Village Hall). Residents would be encouraged to vote for their favoured site(s) for development and also identify any other sites that might have been suggested in the NP questionnaires.	SD
