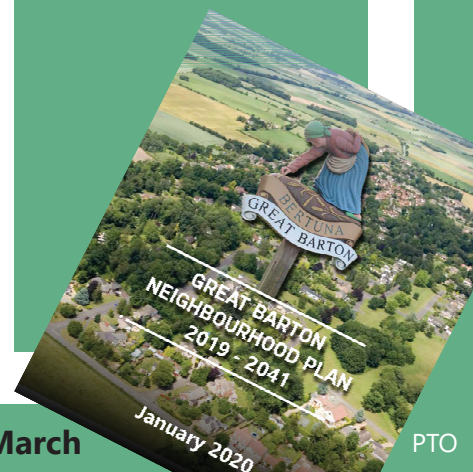
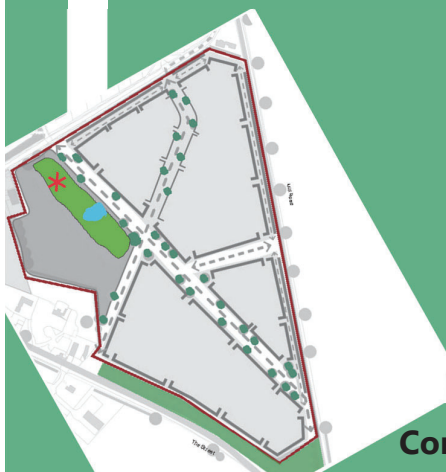
How to comment
