## Section 1 - Introduction

In 2017 the Neighbourhood Plan Working Group designed a Household Questionnaire to help develop the Neighbourhood plan. A copy of the questionnaire can be found at Appendix 1. The distribution of the Neighbourhood Plan Household questionnaire and also a Housing Needs Survey commenced on Saturday 30th September 2017. Every household (over 900 homes) received a copy of the questionnaire asking for the views of each resident over the age of 8 on the issues that should be covered in the Great Barton Neighbourhood Plan. The questionnaires were delivered by hand and wherever possible the person delivering the questionnaire spoke to the residents to explain the purpose of the questionnaire. An envelope was left with the questionnaire and the deliverer returned up three times to collect each questionnaire. Some residents chose to complete the questionnaire online and each household was given a set of six unique identifiers so that everyone over the age of 8 could complete the questionnaire anonymously online. However the majority of residents opted to complete the paper form. This was also done anonymously.

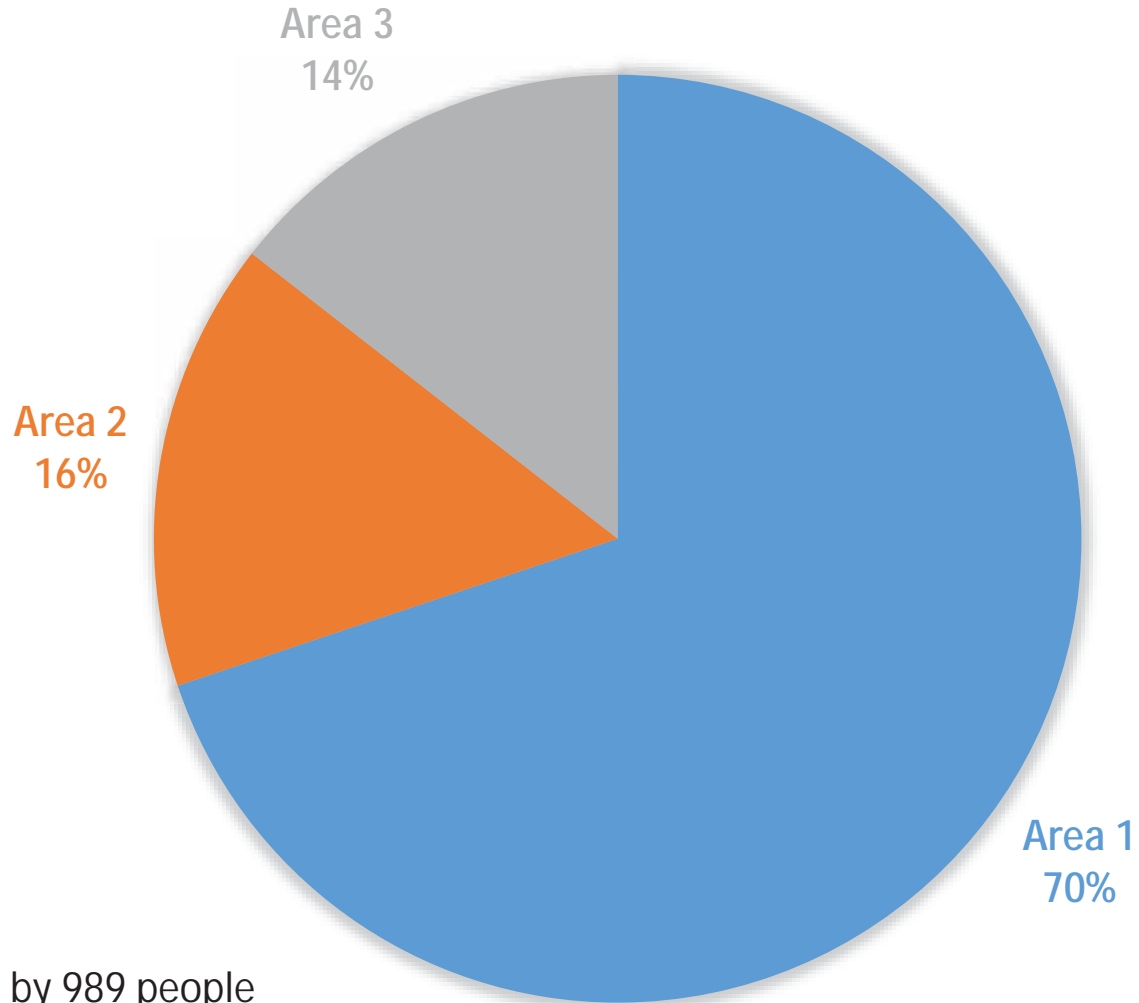

The results of the questionnaire have formed the building blocks for the Neighbourhood Plan.

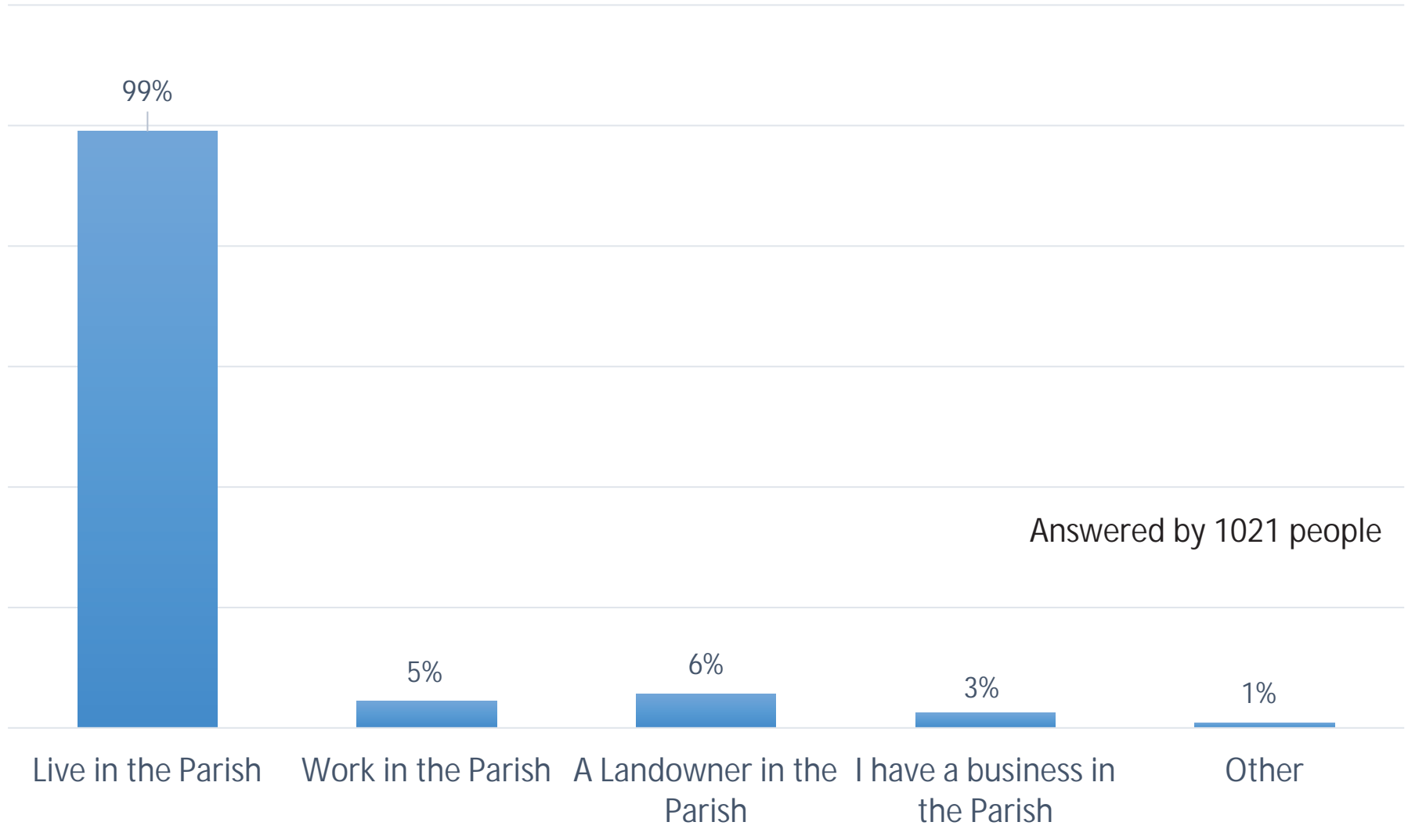

# Q1 Where are you located in the village?

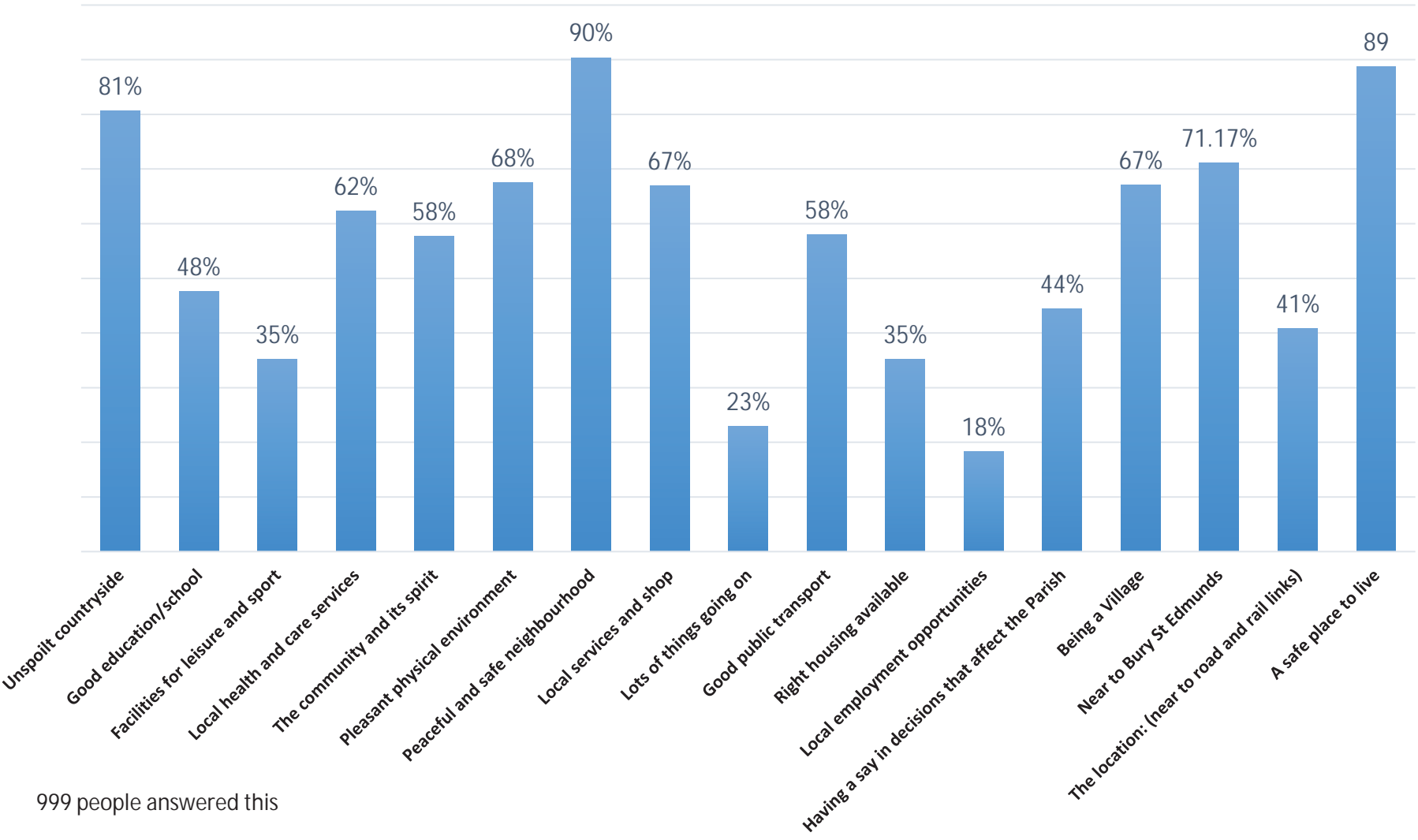

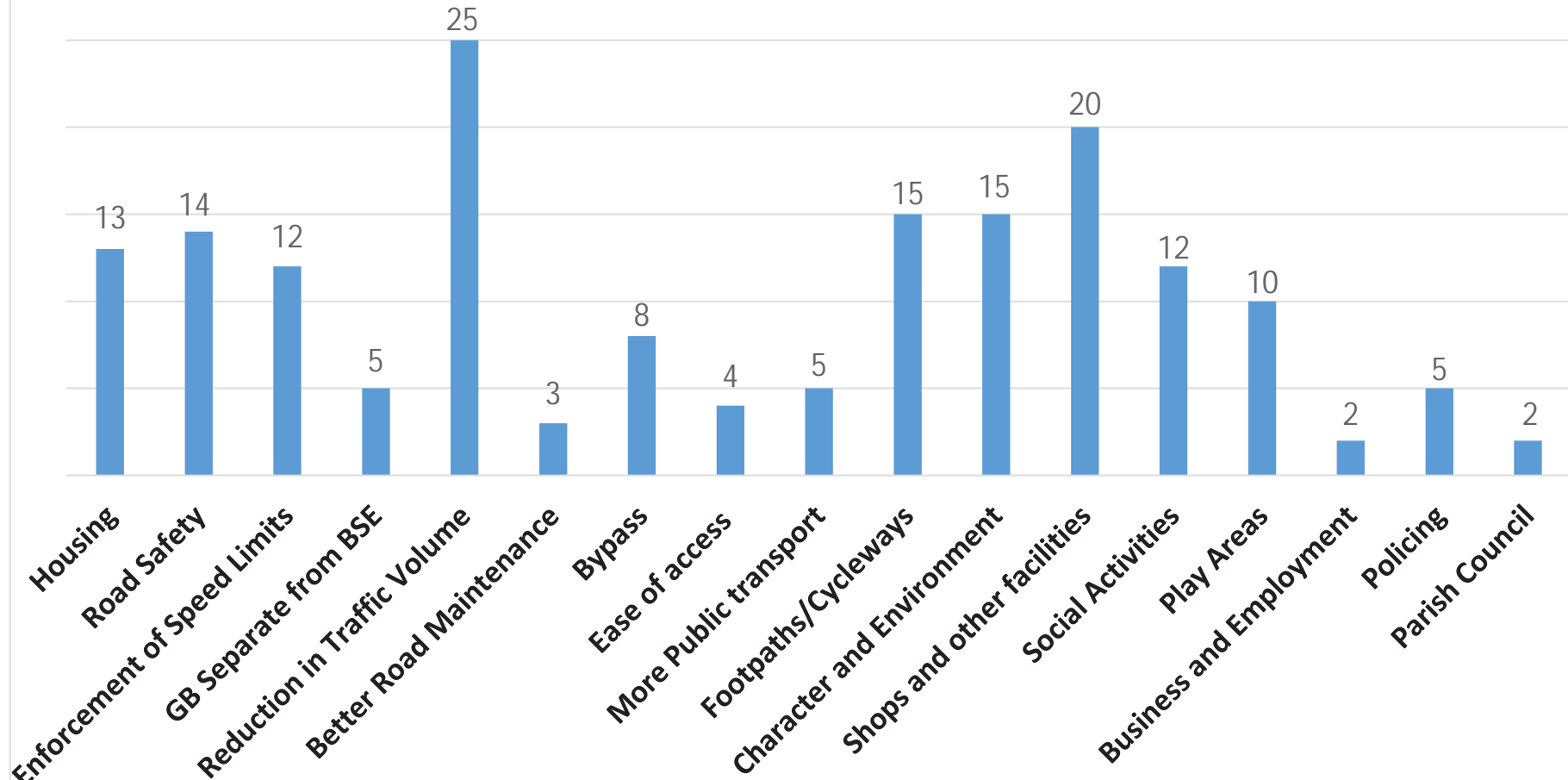
# Q3 Which of the following are important to you?



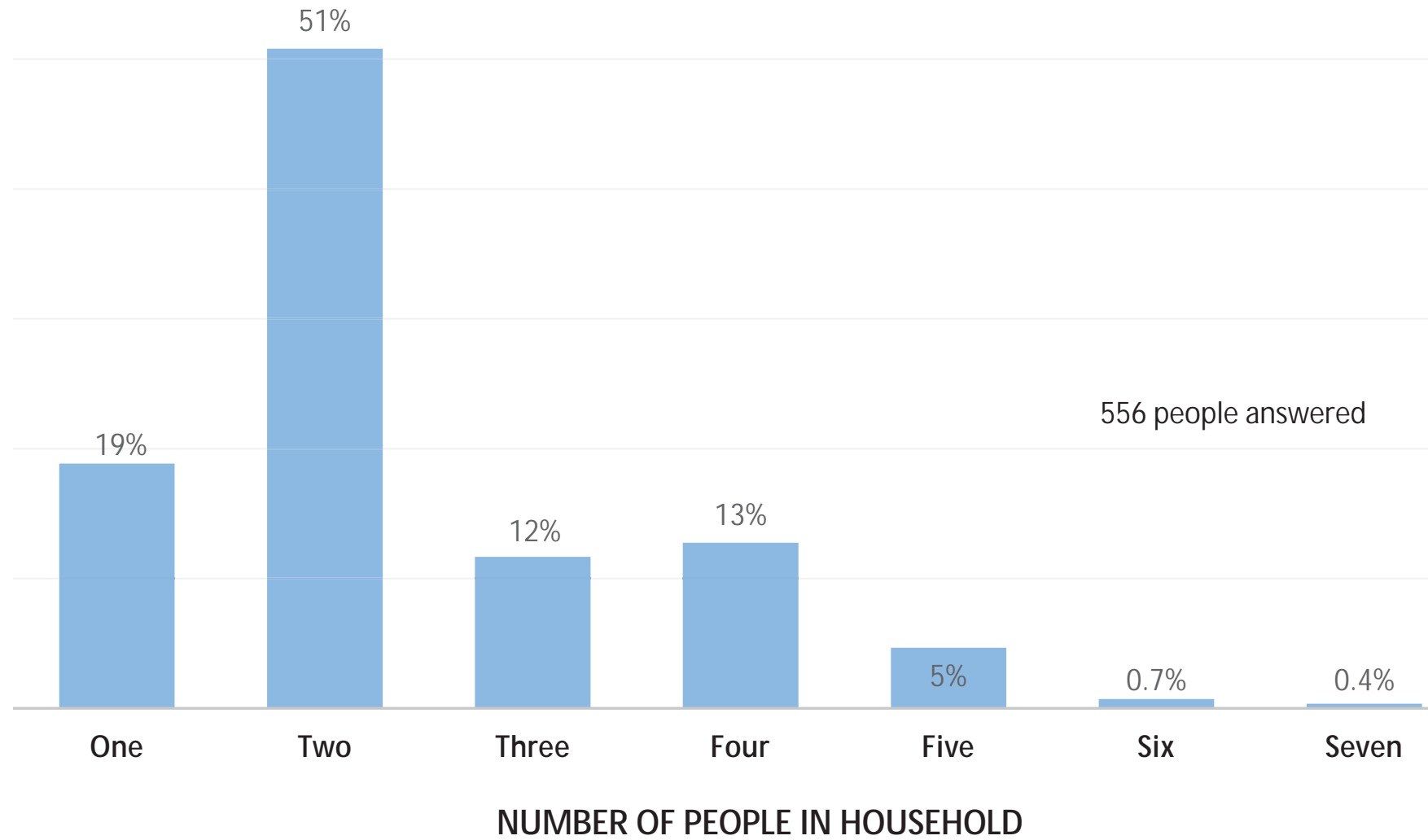

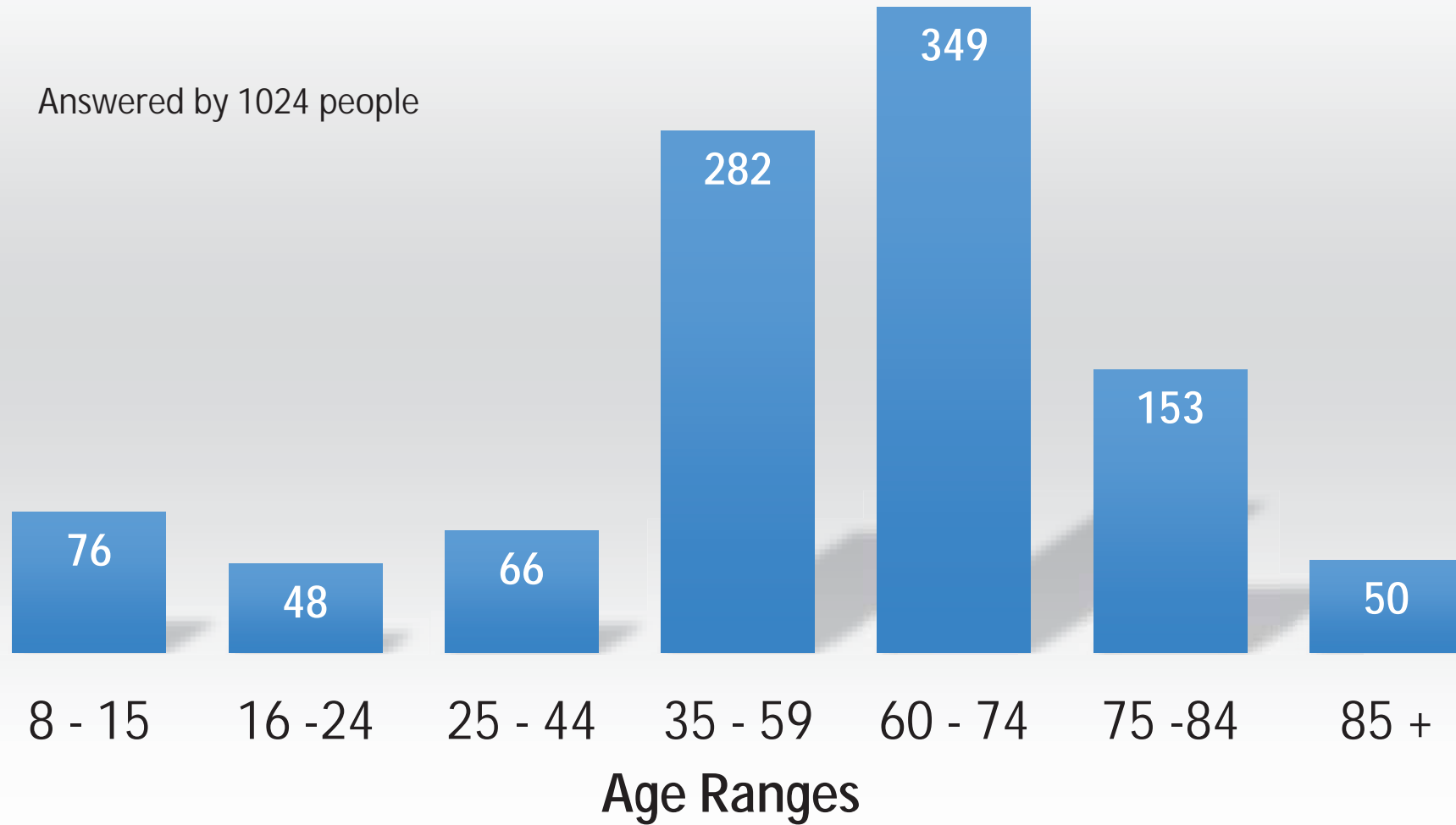
## Q5 How many people in your household?

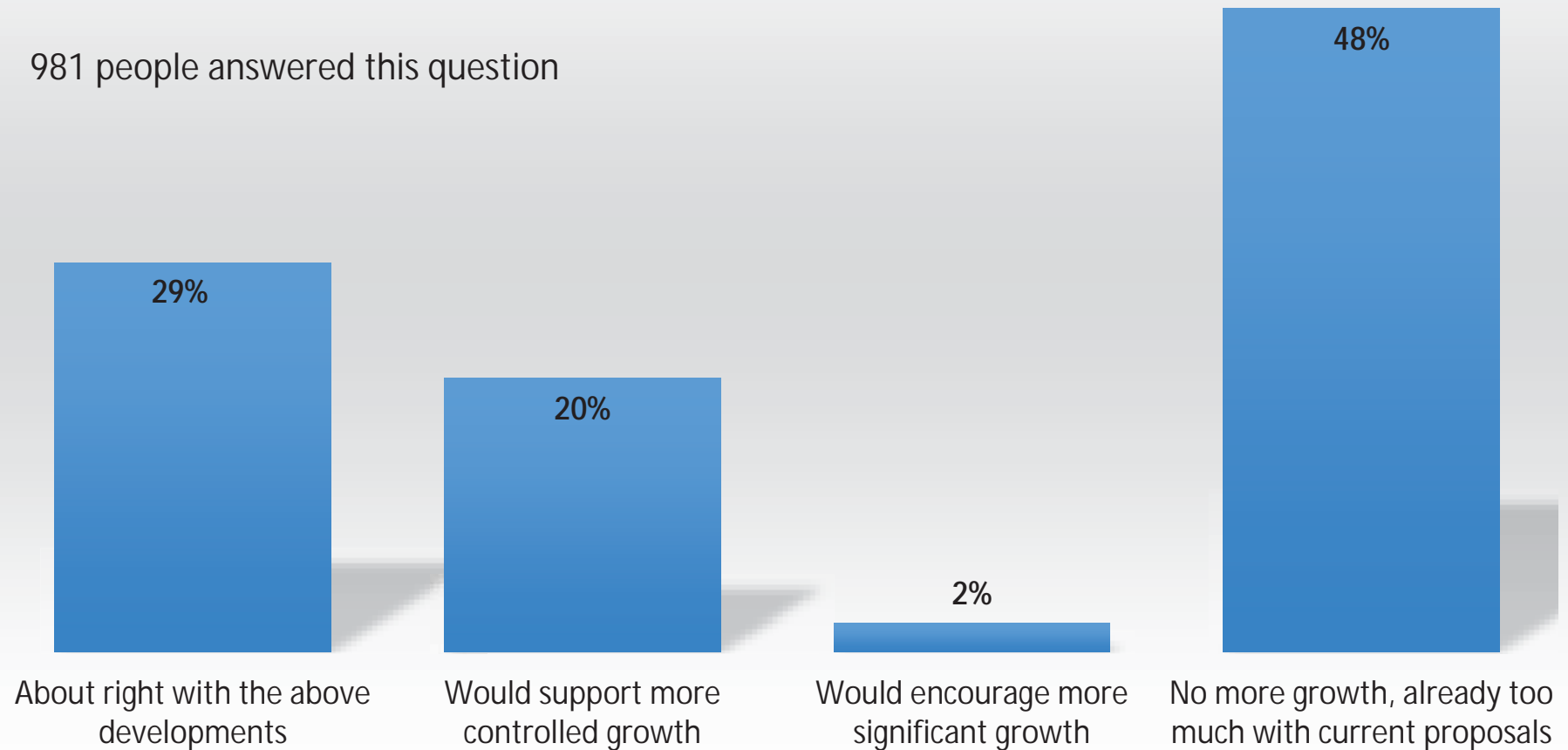

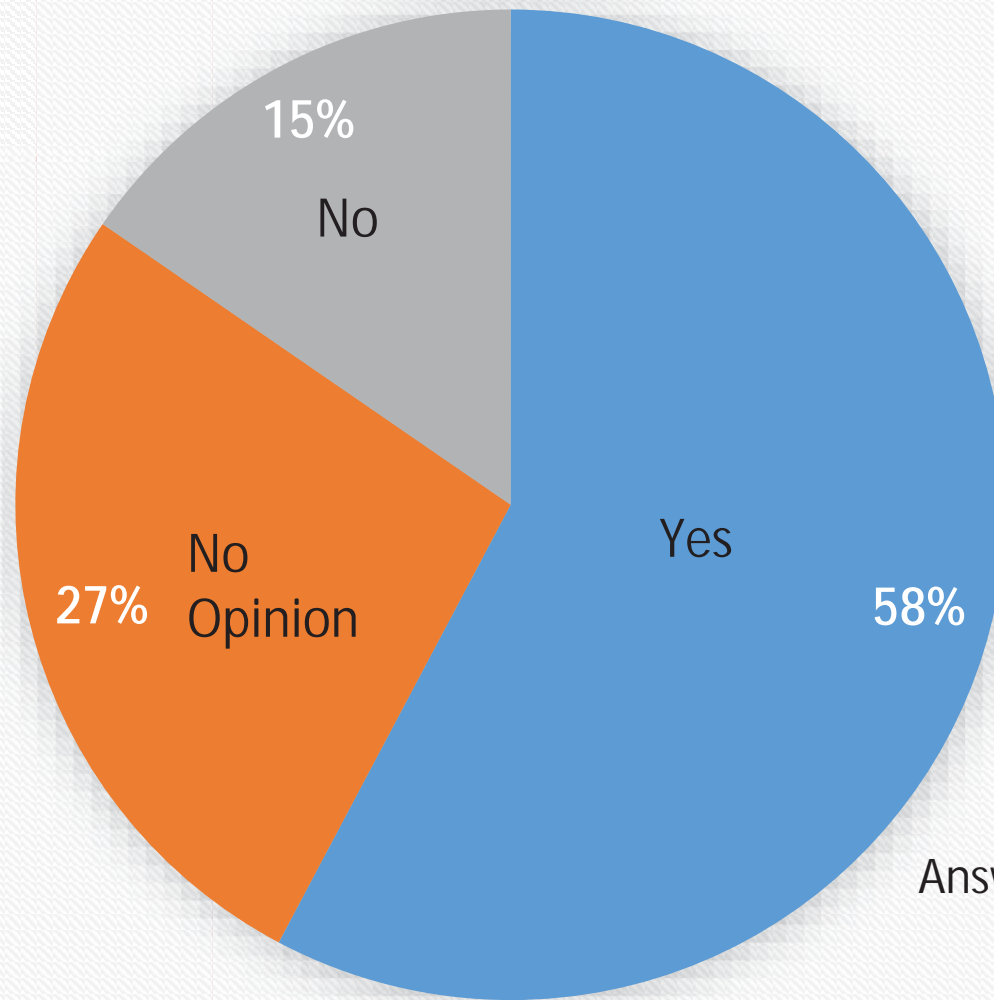

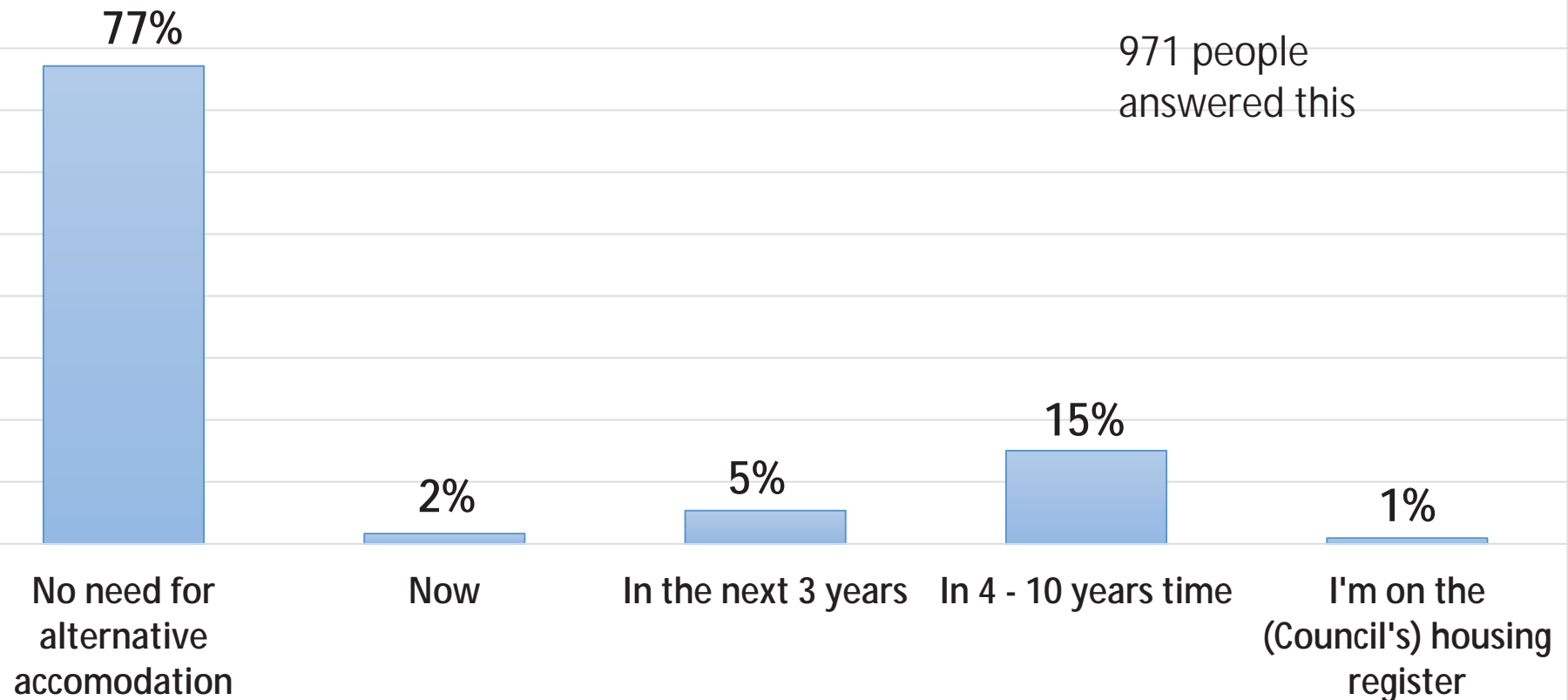


## Q8 Would you support your Neighbourhood Plan allocating sites for Affordable Housing?



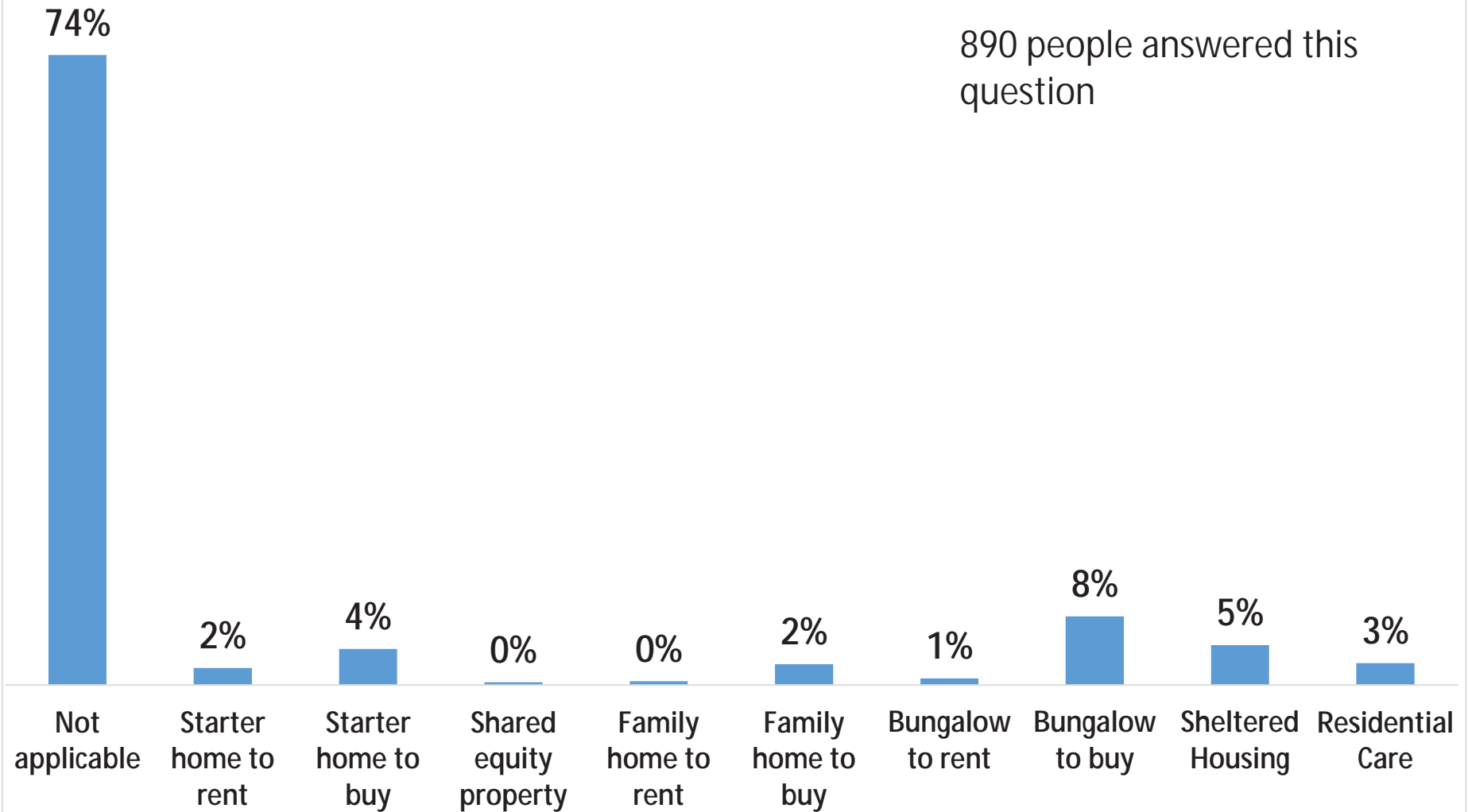

# Q9 Do you anticipate to have a need for alternative accomodation in Great Barton, now or within the next 10 years?

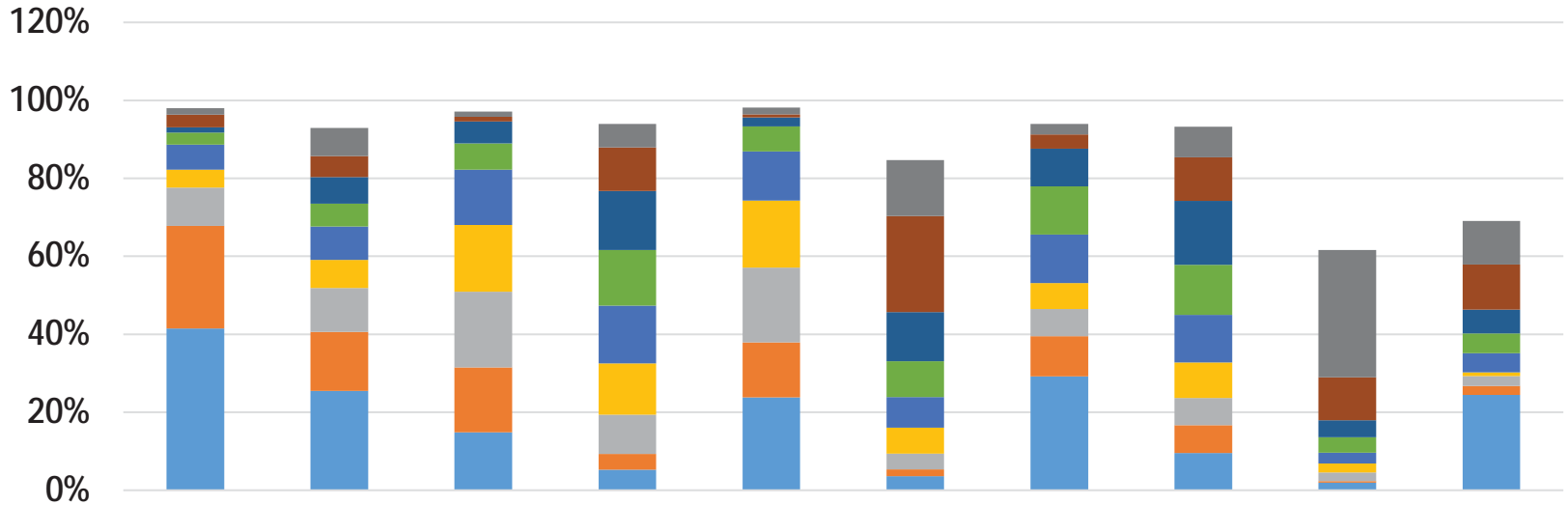


## Q10 What type of accomodation will you be needing?

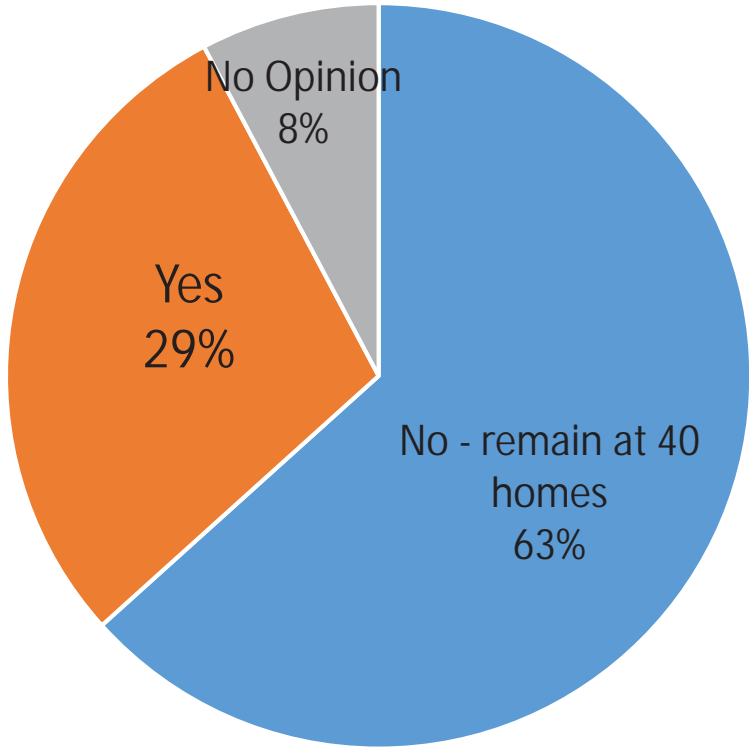
# Q11 What types of homes would you prefer across the Parish?

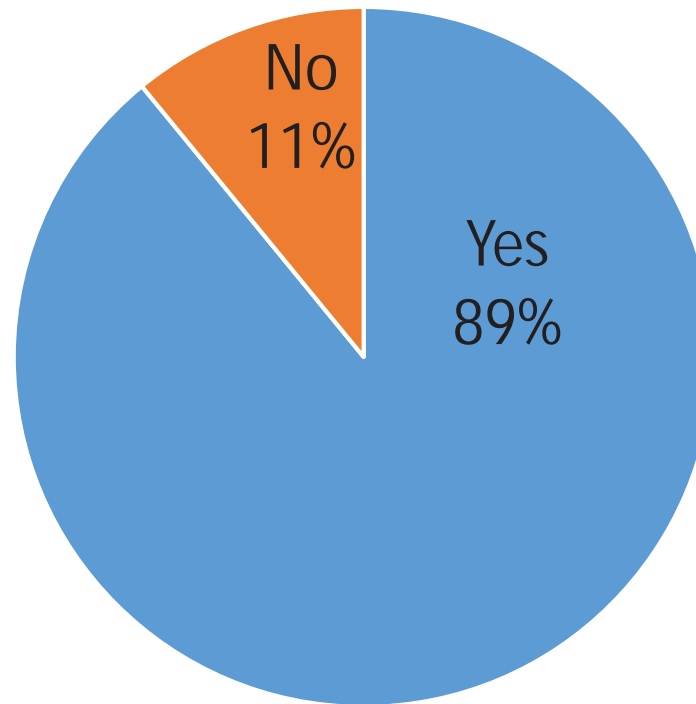

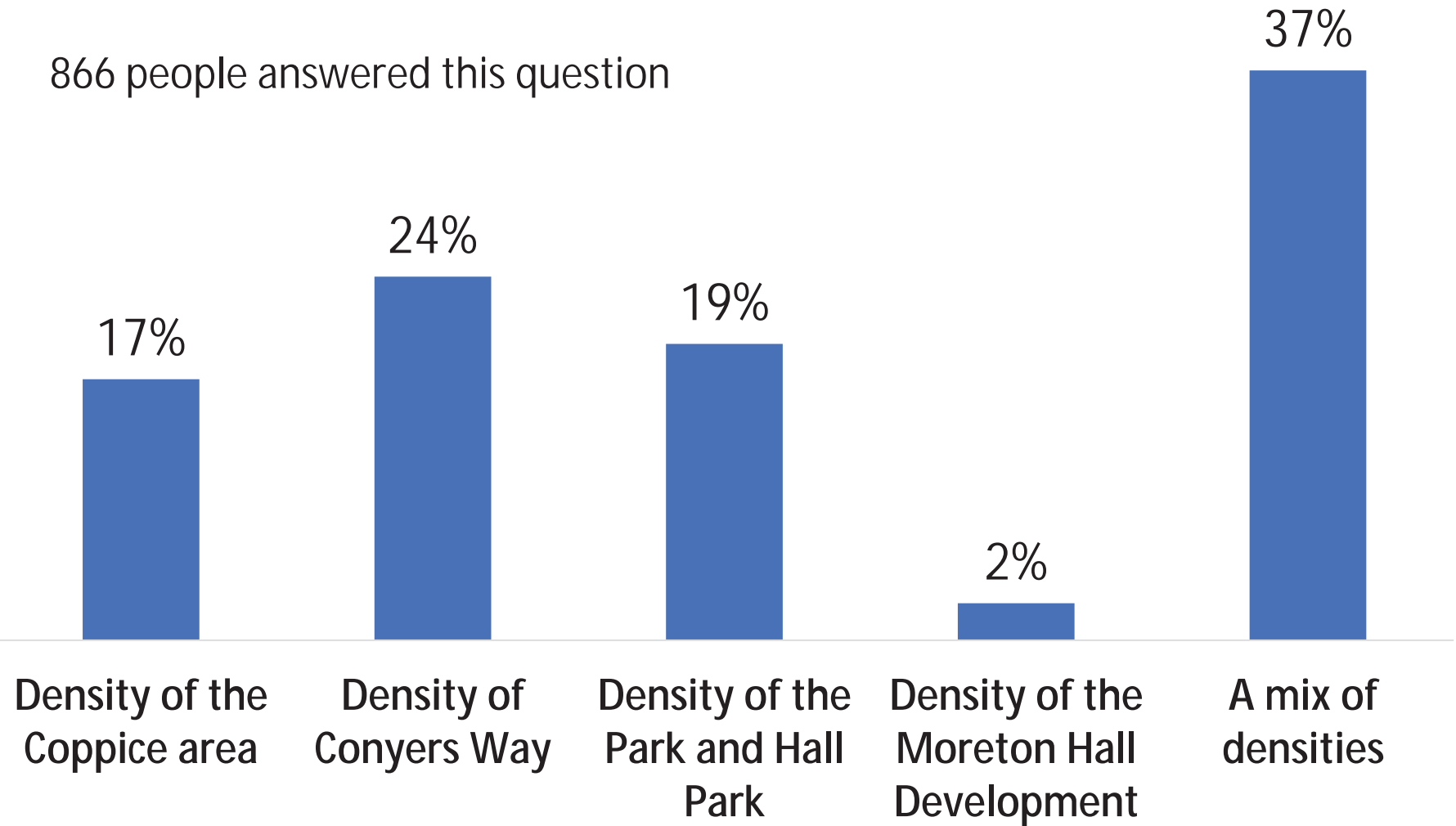
**Q14 Should the Neighbourhood Plan include specific garden sizes and minimum separation distances to maintain current housing densities as typifies Great Barton?**

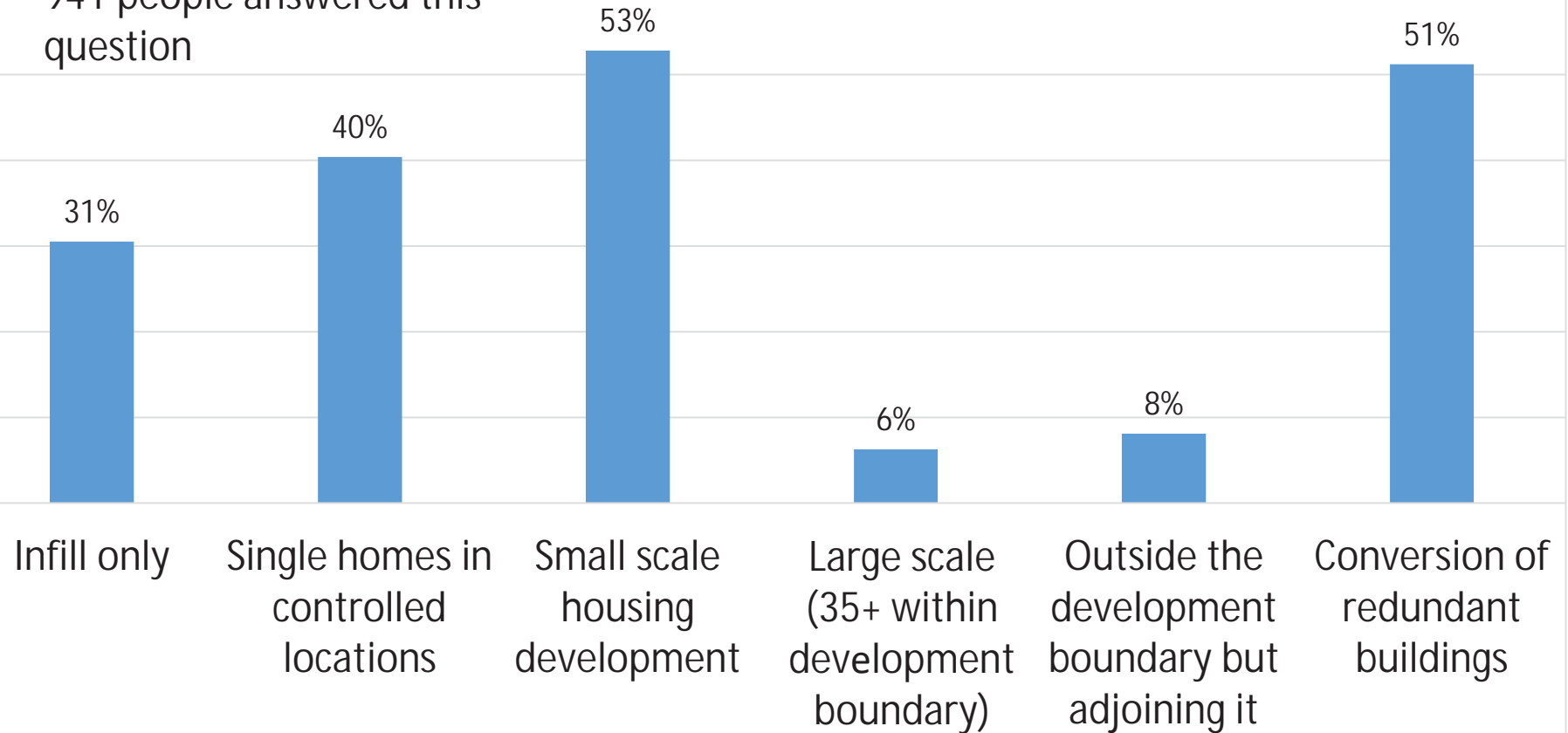
## Q15 If yes to Q14 what would be your density preference?

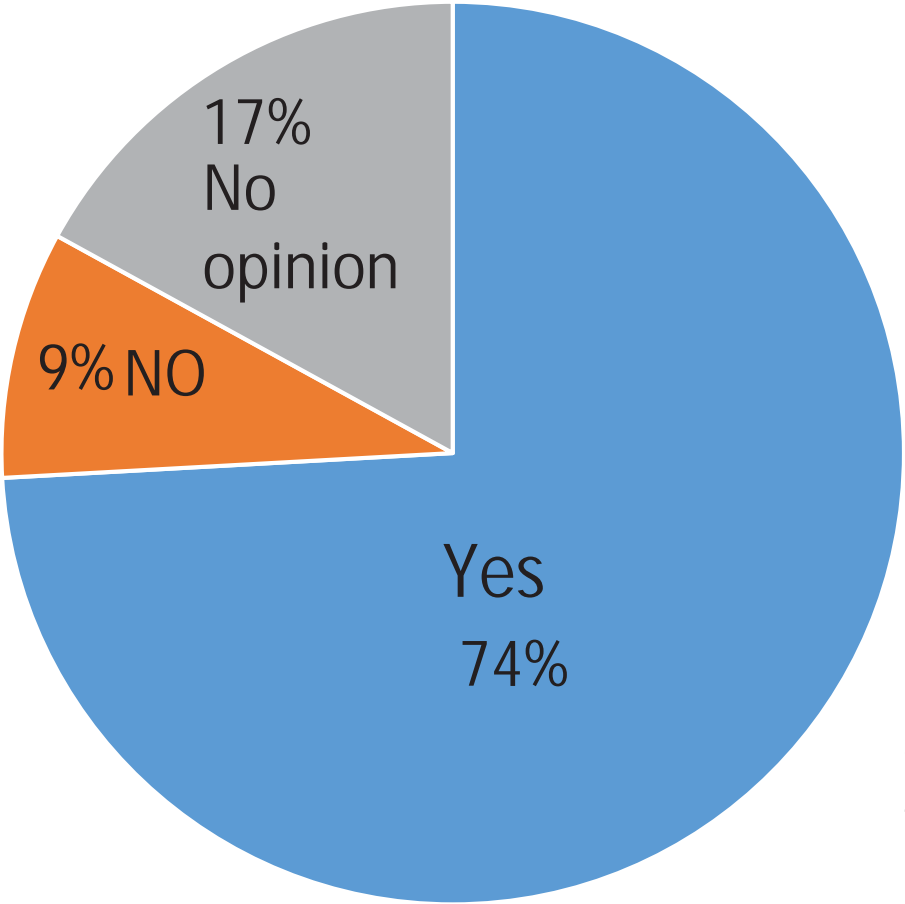


## Q16 What type of housing development would be acceptable to you in Great Barton?

**Q17 The Park and Hall Park are both recognised in the current Development Plan (Local Plan by SEBC) as having unique characteristics. Should this situation remain?**

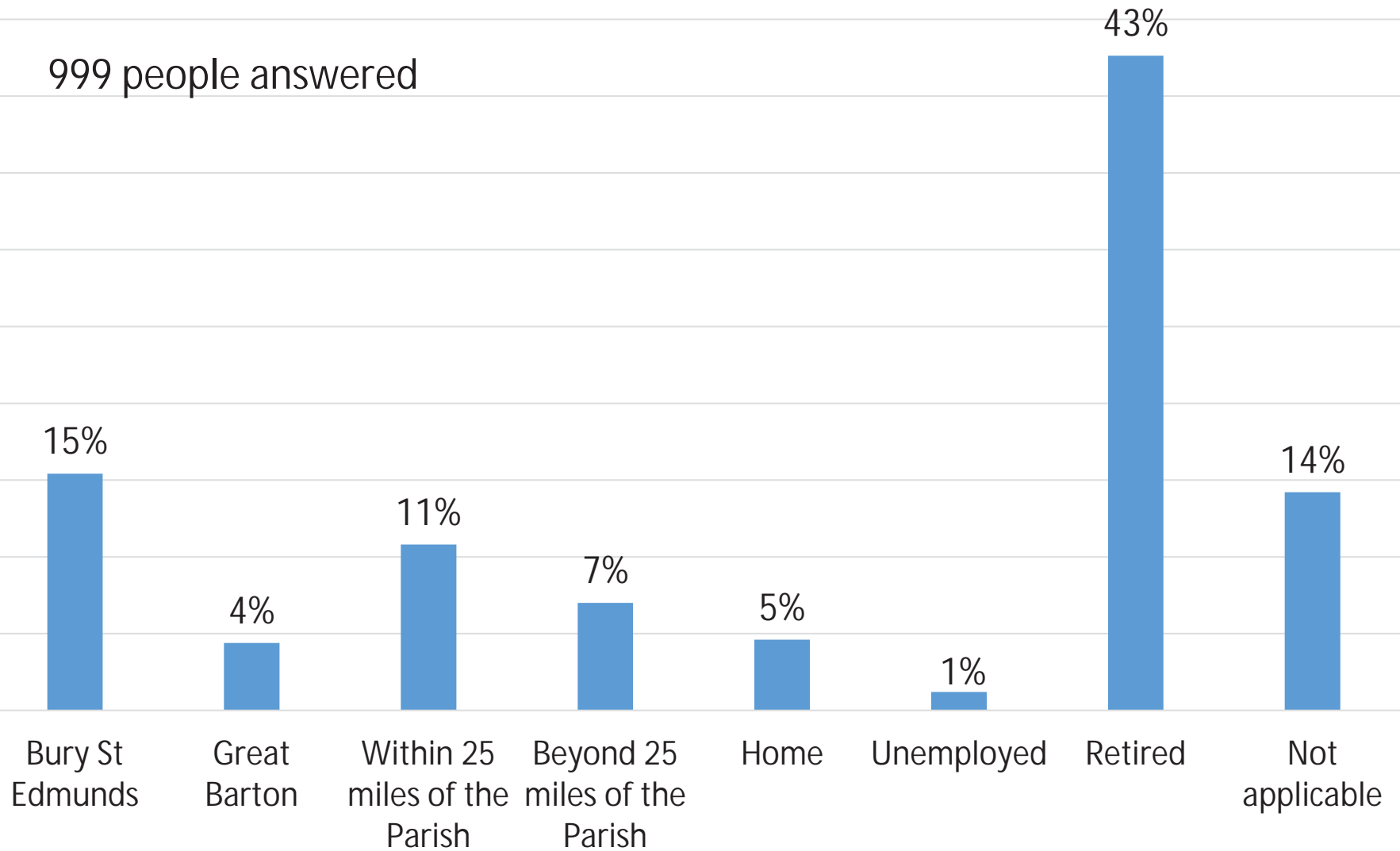

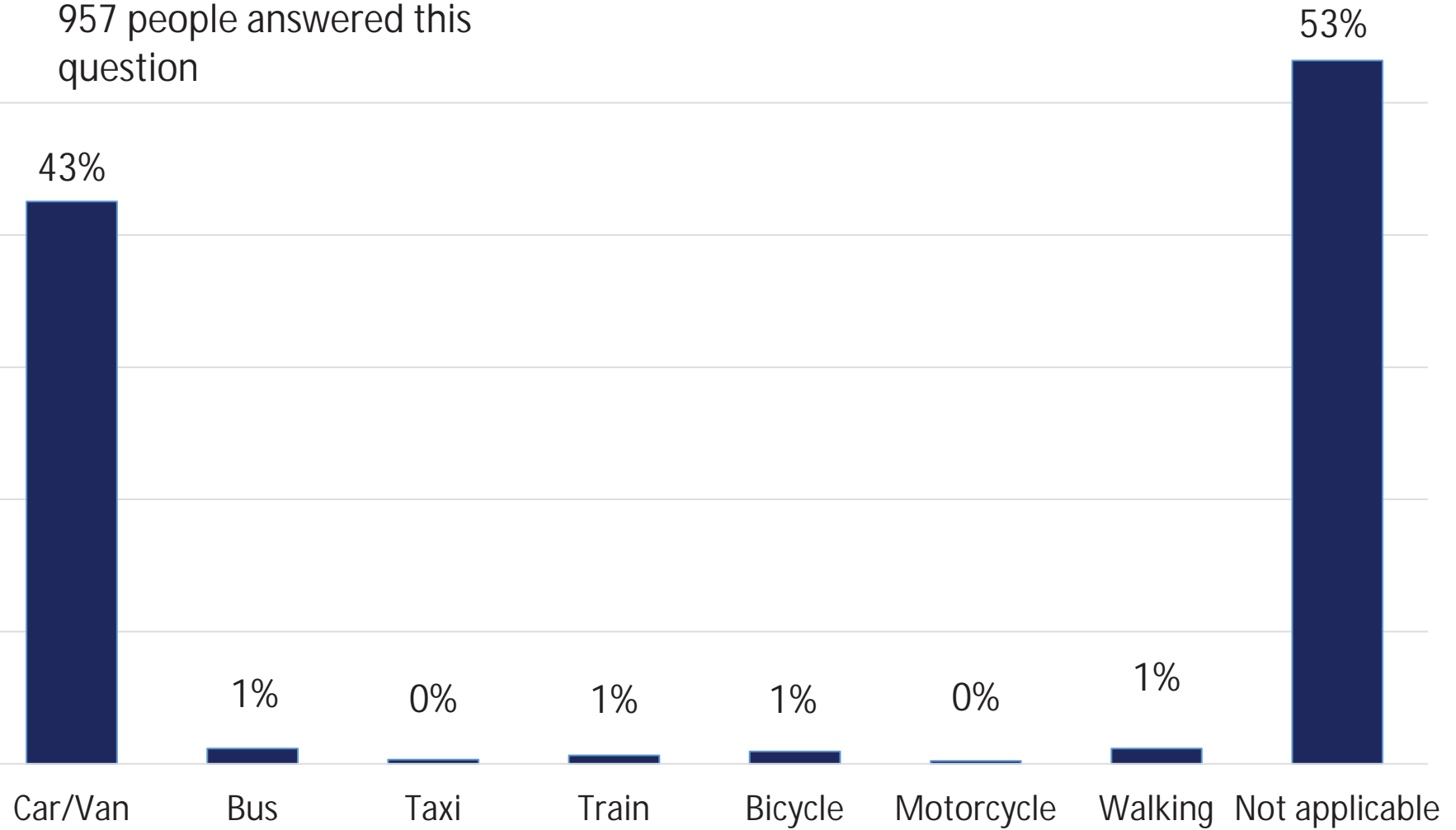

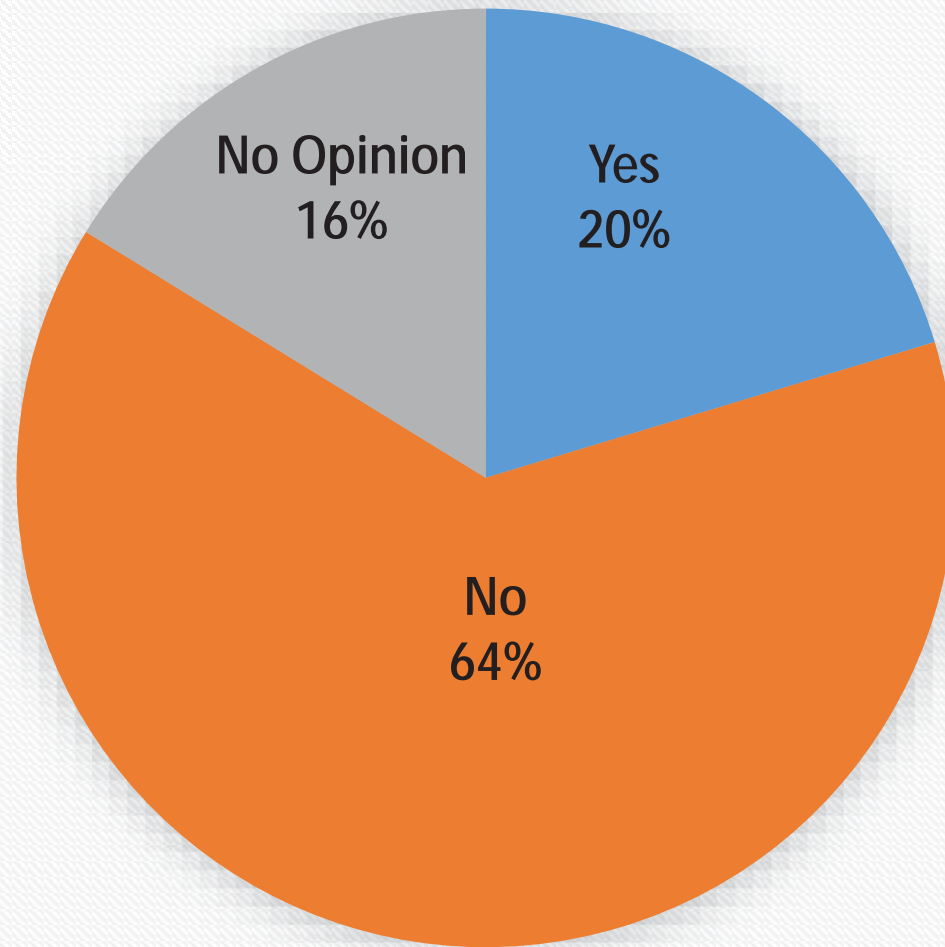


## Q19 What is your main means of transport to work?

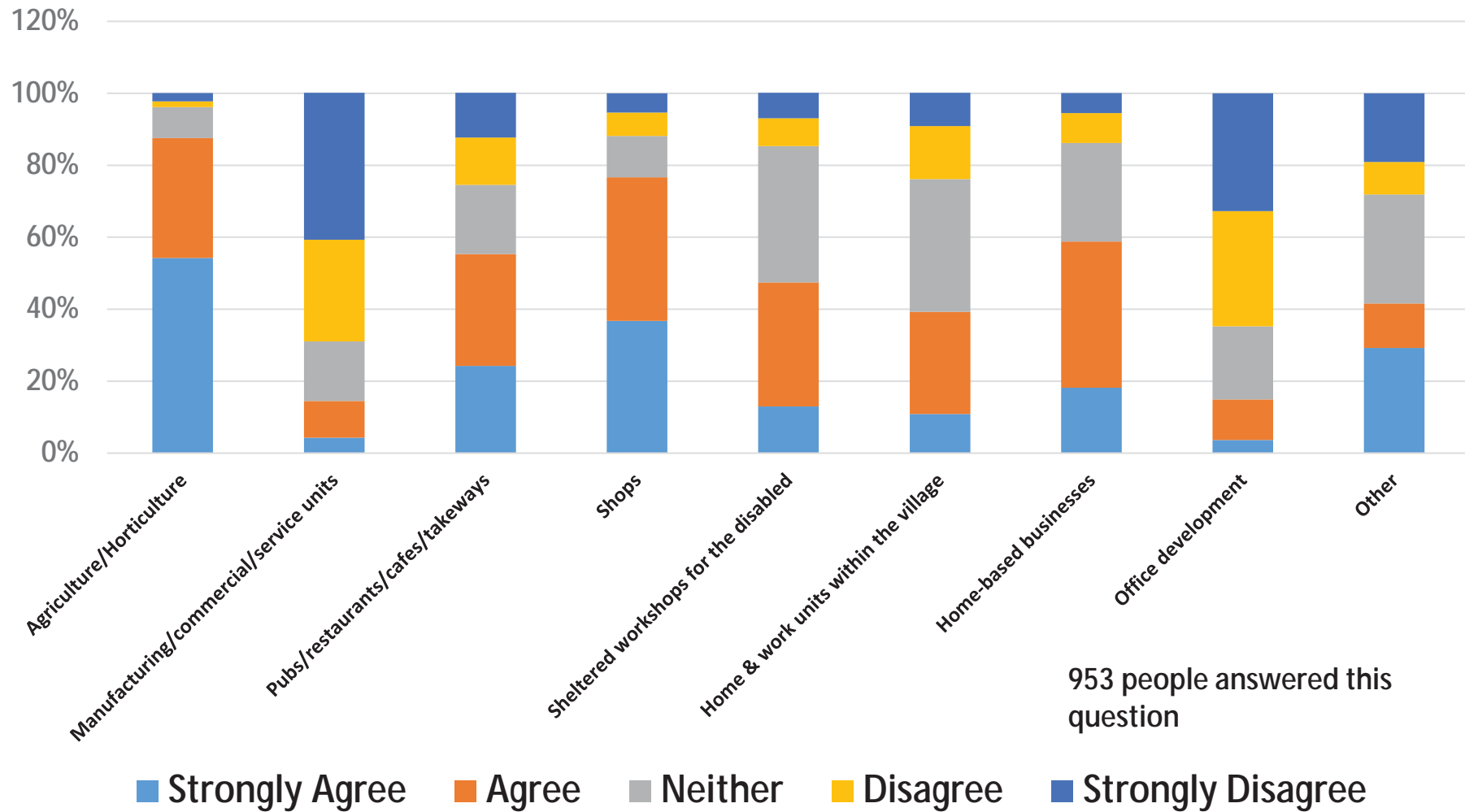


**Q20 Should your Neighbourhood Plan allocate site(s)

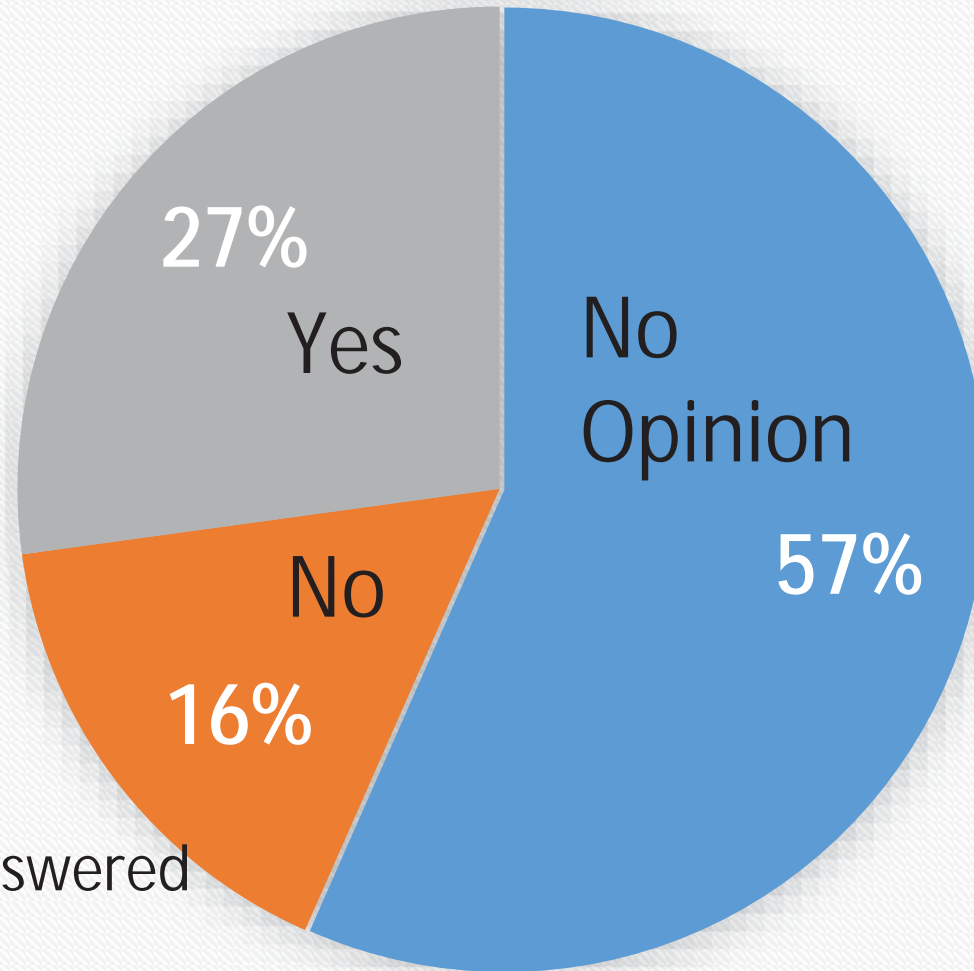




## Q21 Do you agree that the following businesses should be encouraged in Great Barton?



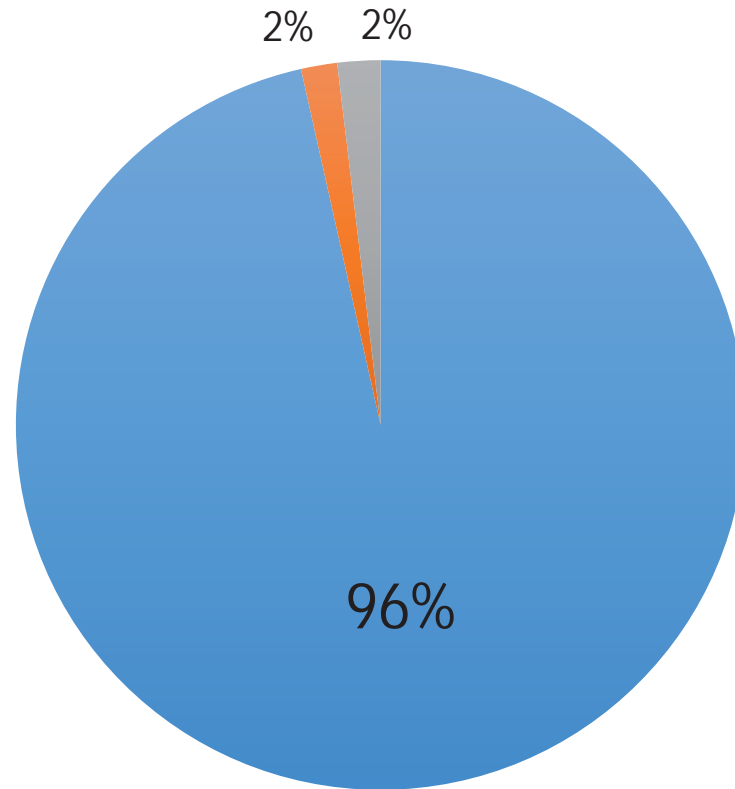
**Q22 Should existing employment sites in the Village be protected from change of use?**

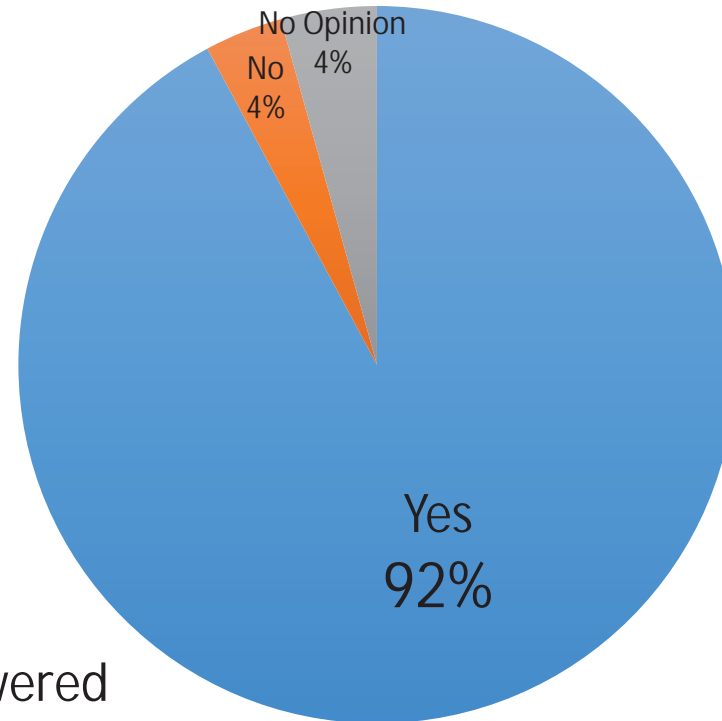
# Q23 Do you think the Neighbourhood Plan should protect existing green places, open and woodland spaces in the Parish?

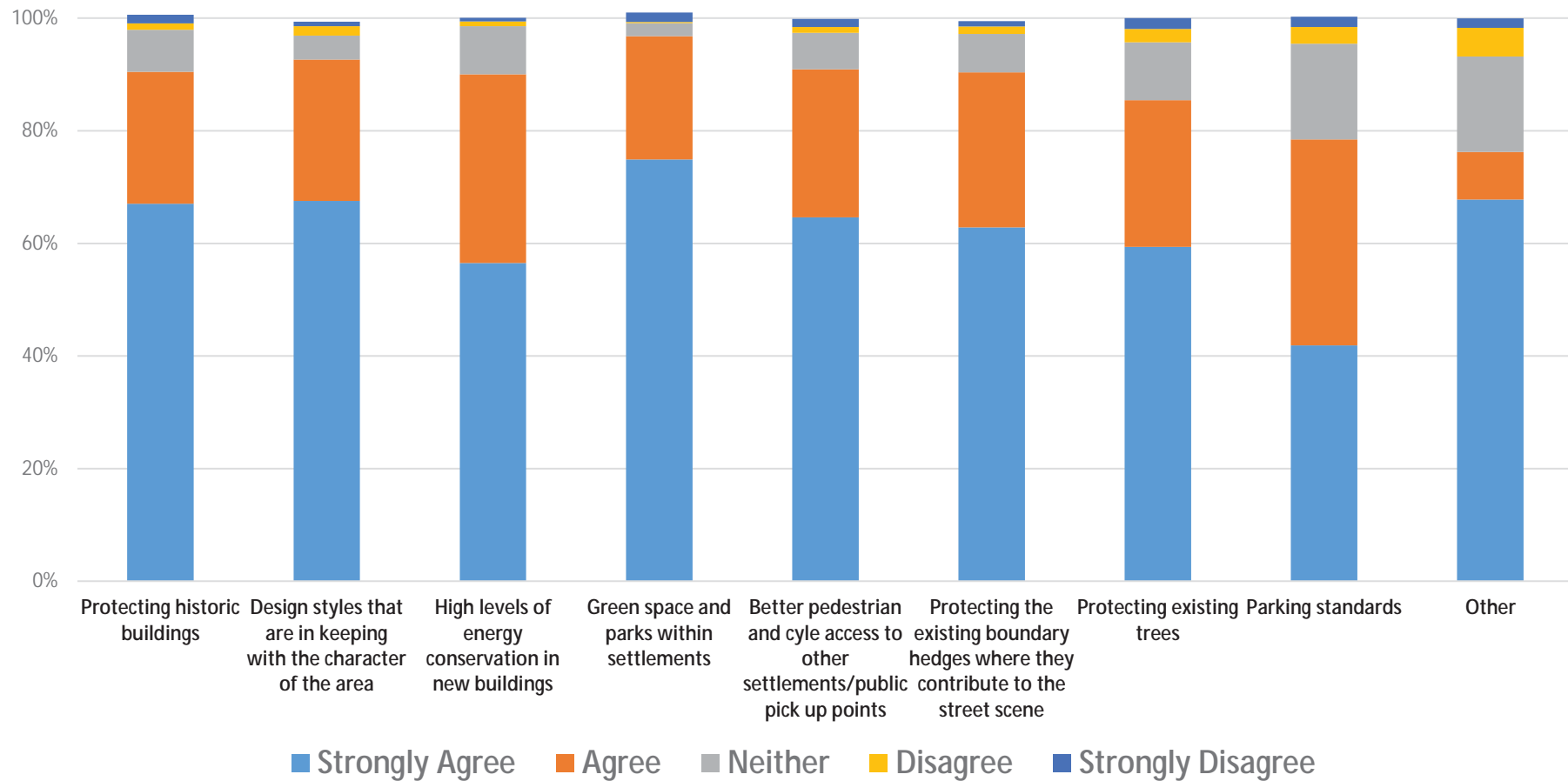
## Q24 Do you think the Neighbourhood Plan should protect the arable/grassland/farmland/landscape within the Parish?



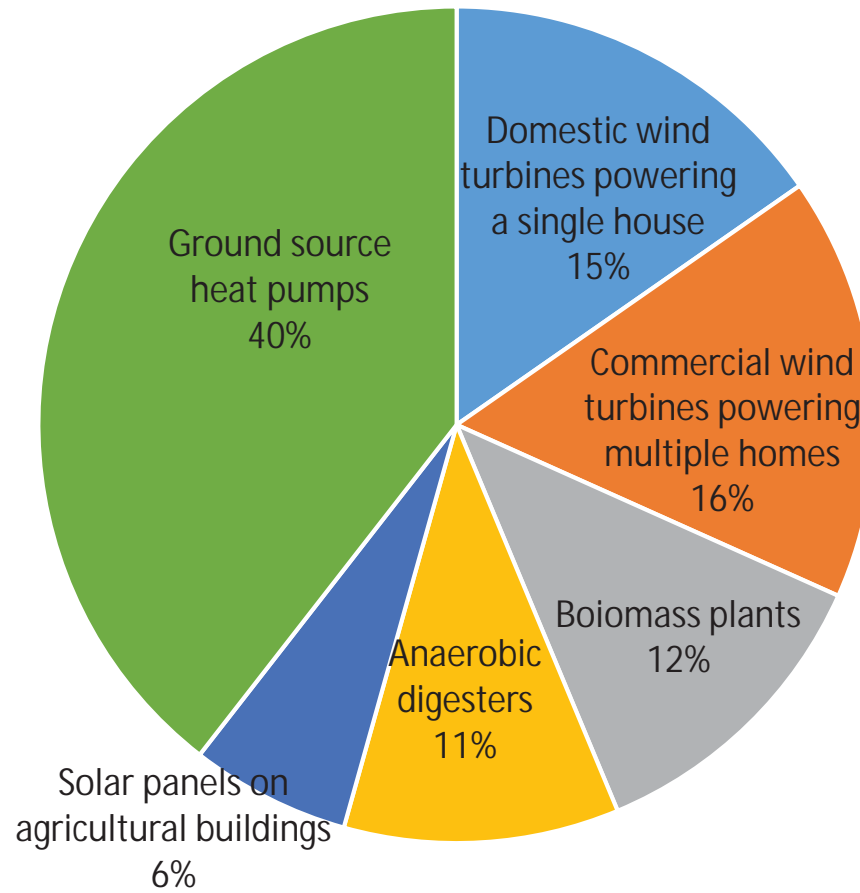

### Q34 Which of the following renewable energy sources would you support in the Parish?

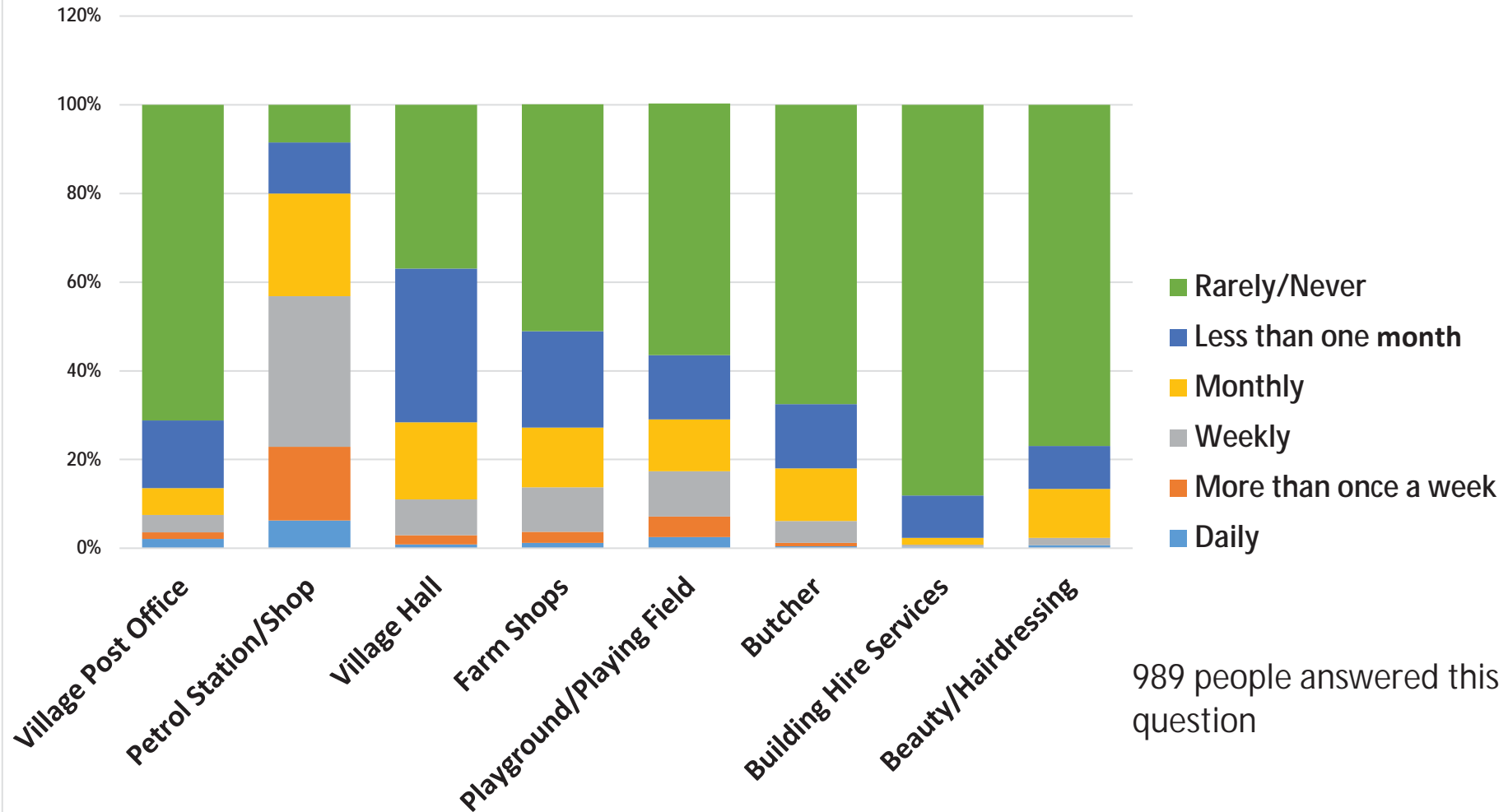

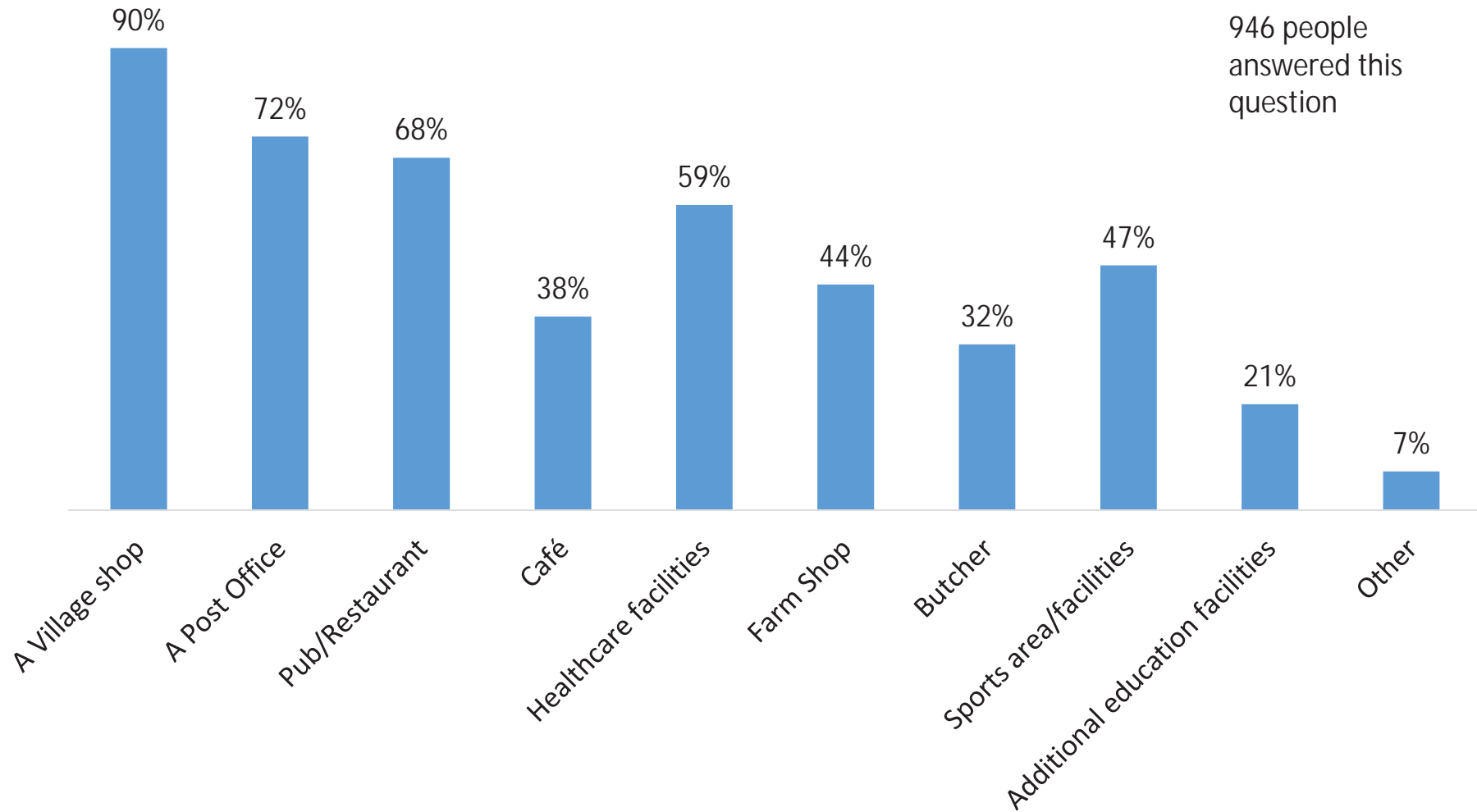

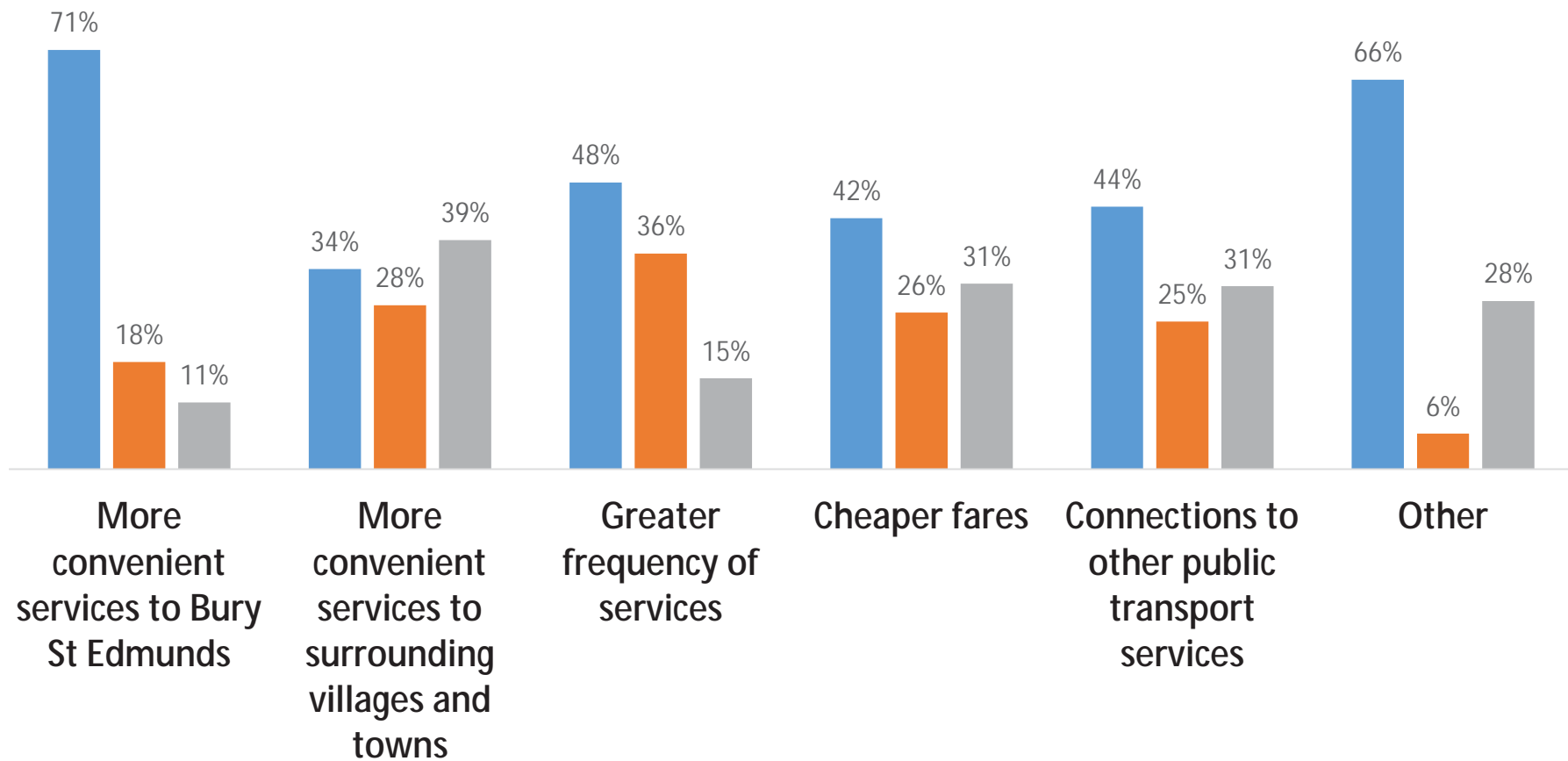

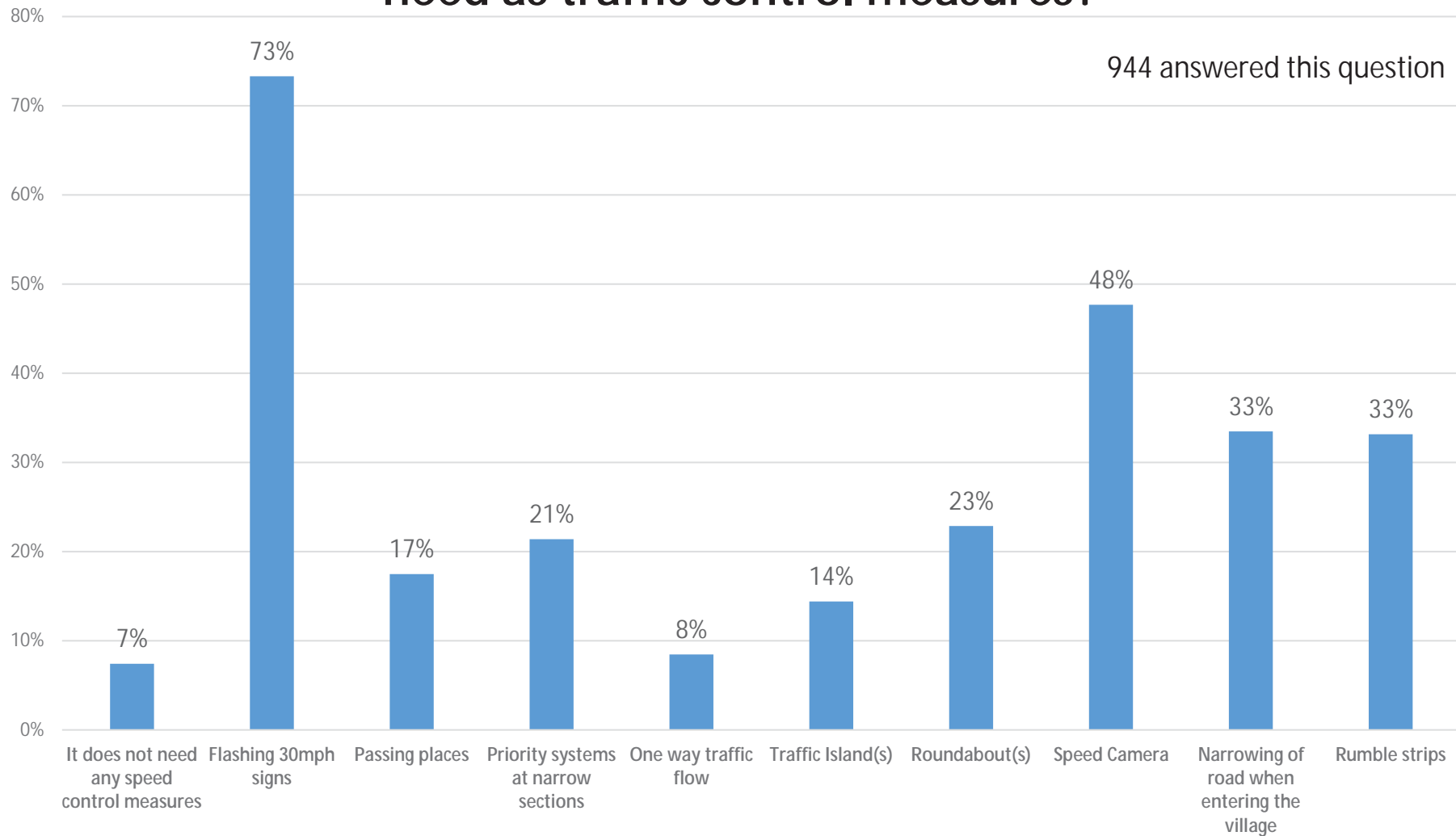

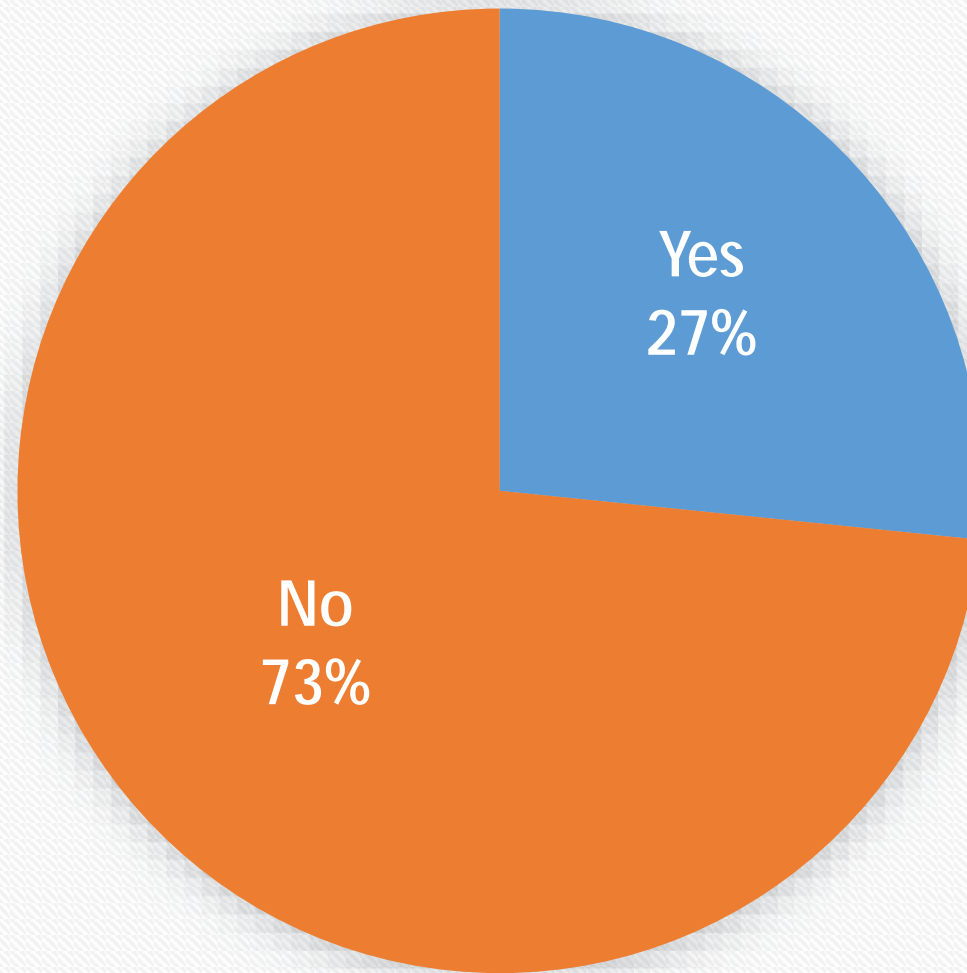


## Q35 Which of the following does Great Barton need as traffic control measures?

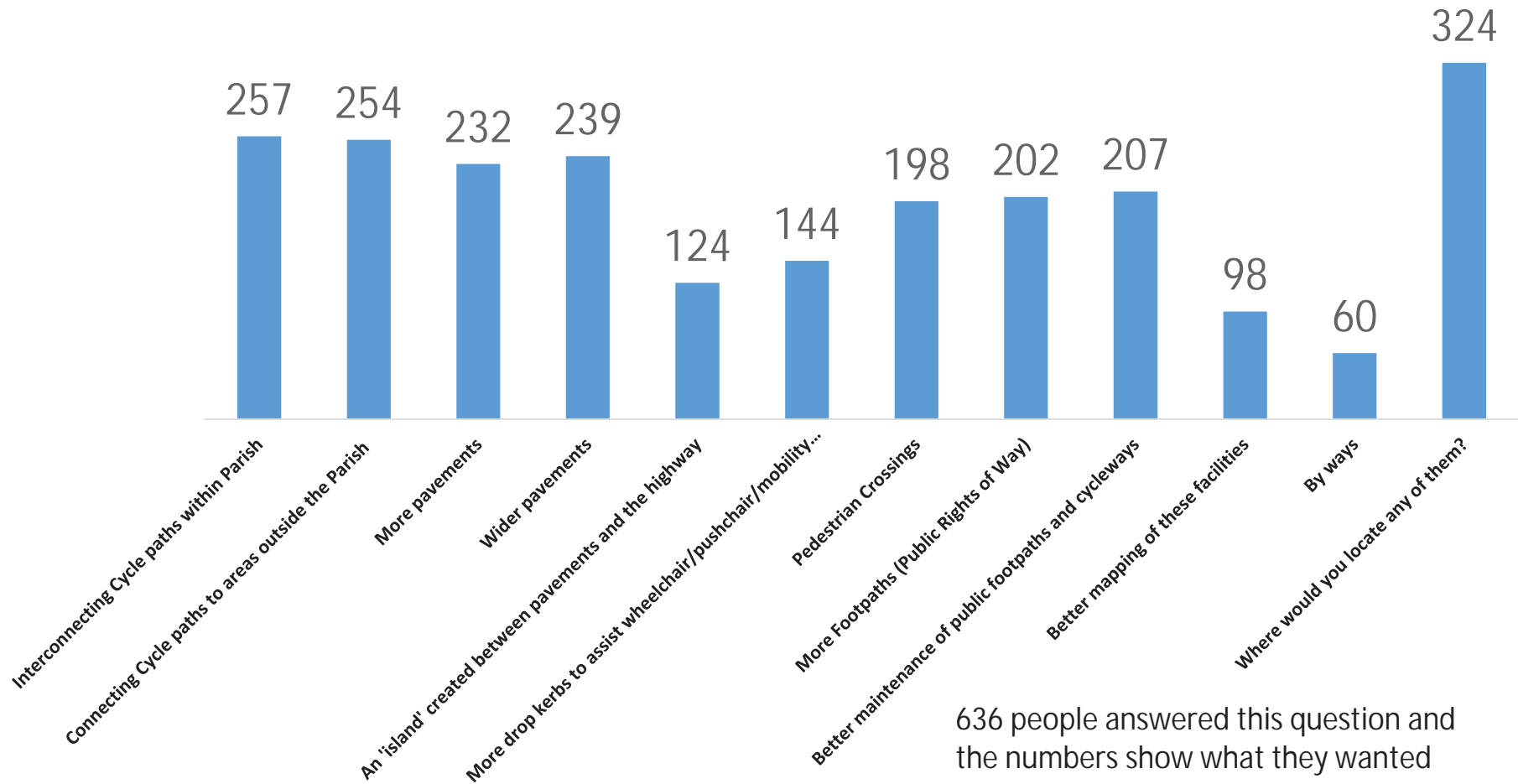


Q36 Are the current roads through the Parish safe

Together, we can ensure the Plan delivers the things needed to keep our community great and make it an even better place in the future.

We want to hear from everyone in your household including children who are 8yrs old and above. We believe that everyone's opinions are important.

This is a real opportunity for you to help shape the future of Great Barton.

It is important that you should answer as many questions as you can. With most of them, it is simply necessary to place a 'tick' or number. Space has, however, been allocated within some questions to allow you to express your views in more detail. Of course, you can decline to answer any question.

We want you to be completely frank in your answers, there are no questions that could identify you and therefore your answers are completely anonymous.

### What is the purpose of the Questionnaire?

The results of this questionnaire will form the basis of the Neighbourhood Plan for our village and in particular the housing section will allow us to formulate planning policies. The Neighbourhood Plan will be subject to a round of public consultation within Great Barton and the local authority before an independent examination to ensure we comply with Local and National Planning Policy guide lines. These policies will then be placed before you under a simple referendum for a "Yes" or "No" for the adoption of these policies. These policies will then be in statute and will be referred to when future planning applications come to the Parish.

A Neighbourhood Plan summary report will become available for every household.

### A Neighbourhood Plan can...

- Decide where and what type of development should happen in the neighbourhood
- Promote more development than is set out in the Local Plan, but not less.
- Include policies, for example regarding design standards, that take precedence over existing policies in the Local Plan for the neighbourhood - provided the Neighbourhood Plan policies do not conflict with the strategic policies in the Local Plan.

### What can a Neighbourhood Plan contain?

So long as your Neighbourhood Plan complies with the above principles, it can be as narrow or as broad as you wish. But it must be primarily about the use and development of land and buildings. It can also have a say in how buildings should look (their 'design'), or the materials they are constructed from.

The Neighbourhood Plan will become a very authoritative planning document report to guide and support St Edmundsbury Borough Council and Suffolk County Councils and other statutory authorities and organisations, including your own Parish Council.

The Principle Objective for ALL OF US in GREAT BARTON is to make OUR VILLAGE a BETTER place to live.

WE can only ACHIEVE this through your HELP in COMPLETING THIS QUESTIONNAIRE.

### Definitions:

**Severalls** (Map 1) is one of 5 major housing developments for Bury St Edmunds which remains in the our parish.

**The Triangle** (Map1) is the housing development bordered by School and Mill Roads and A143.

**Infill housing** is the insertion of additional **housing** units on small plots within an existing development.

**Development Boundary** is the area identified by the Local Planning Authority as the development area of the village.
